



GOVERNMENT-IN-ACTION YOUTH TOUR

ELIGIBILITY:

★You must currently be classified as a sophomore, junior, or senior from Amherst, Anton, Levelland, Littlefield, Olton, Sudan, Whiteface, or Whitharral. Or, your parent or guardian must be a member of Lamb County Electric Cooperative.

CONTEST RULES:

★Participants will be required to appear before an independent panel of judges prepared to discuss the following topics:

- (1) Why should I be chosen as Lamb County Electric Cooperative’s delegate to the 2011 youth tour and what do I expect to gain from the experience?
- (2) Tell what you know about Lamb County Electric Cooperative? (i.e. number of meters, board of directors, counties served, etc.)
- (3) What is the difference between a Cooperative and an investor owned utility?
- (4) What is Texas Electric Cooperatives and what is their function in the youth tour?

★Participants will have 5 – 7 minutes of interview time

★Judges will have the opportunity to ask questions (*hint: know and understand cooperatives*)

JUDGING:

Winners will be chosen on how well they “present themselves” in an interview setting by answering the four questions listed above (80 percent) and on their speaking ability, appearance and poise (20 percent).
